



TRAVEL INFO

Travel Dates for our Brazilian Rainforest Adventure are August the 14th to the 22nd, 2025, including flight days.

Other than booking your flights, we've taken care of everything for you!

FLIGHT INFORMATION: Book your own flights (not included)

- From your origin city, choose your own flight that **arrives at the Panama City Tocumen International Airport (PTY), on August 14th, 2025, no later than 7:30 PM.** Earlier is better. You're welcome to arrive earlier if you'd like to spend more time in Panama City on your own.

- **Book COPA AIRLINES FLIGHT CM141 from Panama City (PTY) to Manaus–Eduardo Gomes International Airport (MAO) - Brazil, departing on August 14th 9:35 PM.** Our entire group should be on this flight to Manaus. (Unless you prefer to arrive in Manaus earlier, making your own arrangements - if so you'll need to meet our group at MAO for pickup).*

TRANSFER FROM AIRPORT TO BOAT: Included, we've got you!

Your flight should land in Manaus around 2:38 AM of the 15th, and in order to make the best use of our time, you will be transported directly from the airport (we will provide the meeting spot) to our houseboat ship the "Otter", that will be waiting for us on the shores of Rio Negro. The starting point for our trip!

TRANSFER FROM BOAT TO AIRPORT: Included, we've got you!

The last night, our group will be transported directly from the boat for a late night transfer back to the airport (12:30 am drop off) for our early morning Copa Airlines flight from Manaus to Panama City on the 22nd, arriving at 6:30am. Say goodbye to your new plant friends and catch your individual flights back to your home destination!

TRAVEL INSURANCE: Prior to travel, please purchase your own travel/trip insurance to cover you in case of trip interruption, illness that prevents you from joining, etc. Additional coverage for international medical emergencies is recommended.

CURRENCY: The airport takes credit cards and you can pay your cash bar tab or optional tips in U.S. dollars on the boat, so no need to exchange. The Brazilian Real (BRL) is the official currency of Brazil.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS & HEALTH AND WELLNESS

Travel Visa: A travel visa is required for US Citizens to visit Brazil (your passport alone will not grant you entry). The visa application process is fully digital and can be completed online at least 15 days before the intended arrival date. **Apply HERE at the Brazilian government-authorized website**

Valid Passport: Make sure your passport is up to date and will not expire sooner than 6-months after trip dates, plus has two blank pages available.

Recommended Vaccines: Flu Shot, Updated Covid, Yellow Fever, Hepatitis A&B, Diphtheria and tetanus, MMR. Check with your a travel clinic or Dr. at least 6-8 weeks in advance of our trip. Some vaccines must be administered over the course of several months. There are travel vaccine offices that are full service and helpful information. **Covid Test:** For everyone's health and safety, we recommend Covid-19 testing prior to travel/boarding, as well as masking on your flights. Let's stay healthy and have fun!

Malaria Medication: Optional for you and your choice. While mosquitoes are typically not present in the areas we travel through our trip, malaria is present in the Amazon region. Medication must be started before the trip, so check with your provider.
