

PLANTING DATES FOR VEGGIE SEEDS & TRANSPLANTS FOR DFW/NORTH TEXAS AREA

KEY: Time to Seed in Outdoor Garden (0G) / Time to start seeds for transplants Indoors (IN) Transplant dates are for 4"-5" pot size transplants (seedlings). Larger 1gal transplants may be set out in the garden a little bit later than smaller transplants.


This list is not comprehensive...if there are similar crops you want to grow not listed, choose dates for plants most like them.



Gardening is Hyper-local!


Your perfect timing for edible crops will depend on your local environment and climate conditions, which can vary from zip code to zip code. After experimentation and experience, you will learn the specific timing that works best for you for each given crop and microclimate. Also, know that soil in raised beds and mounded beds warms faster than in-ground beds. So, seeds may sprout earlier, and transplants may settle in a little earlier in these types of beds. Don't get discouraged if crops don't work well for you the first time, or a few times thereafter. Growing successfully takes repetition and experience!
